Rules and Procedures

Individual teachers may apply for grants up to \$500; teams of educators may apply for grants up to \$2,000.

Eligible educators include teachers and principals in North Carolina public schools serving grades K-12.

Application limit: One proposal per educator. An applicant for an individual grant may not also apply as the leader of a team project. However, an applicant for an individual grant may be part of one team project for which another educator is seeking Bright Ideas funds.

Applications will be accepted for projects to enhance learning in any discipline or in multiple disciplines.

Proposals may be approved for partial funding when the application's budget includes a figure for the minimum grant required to conduct the project on a smaller scale.

A panel of independent judges, made up of former and current educators and administrators, will review the applications and select the grant recipients.

Selection Criteria

Each proposal will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Project must directly benefit students through innovative and creative teaching methods.
- Project must provide ongoing benefit and allow for replication in other settings.
 - Project should directly involve as many students as possible without compromising its instructional value.
- Grants under this program must supplement, not replace, state and local funding.
 - Project goals and learning objects must be clearly defined.
 - Two or more teachers may work jointly on a single project.
 - Project must include a measurable evaluation of its success/outcome.
- The application must include a schedule of project activities and the project must be completed within the 2021/2022 school year.
